
Vietnam Mosaics

Even though COVID-19 presented challenges in 2020, the mosaics have been completed and were lifted into place on Saturday 12 December. The Artist, Simon Normand, has done an excellent job and many Vietnam Veterans worked on this project. Jeff Freeman donated his Dog Tags (pictured over) and they have been incorporated into the mosaic.
